Sickness

If your child is unwell and not attending school please telephone us on the first day of their sickness to let us know.

IF YOUR CHILD HAS ANY SYMPTOMS OF COVID 19 THEY MUST STAY AT HOME AND TAKE A PCR TEST. IF POSITIVE THEY MUST **ISOLATE FOR 10 DAYS AND IF NEGATIVE THEY CAN AT-TEND SCHOOL.**

It is vital that all families follow this quidance to ensure we can keep our full school community safe.

Where a pupil displays gastrointestinal symptoms such as diarrhoea or vomiting they must not attend school until they have been symptom free for 2 days.

Learning For The Month

All classes will continue to focus on health and well being as well as respiratory hygiene. Other things we will be covering:

P1/2: Literacy: word building with the first set of sounds; learning ck, e, r,m,d, g, o, u, l, f, b, word blending and building, Listening skills, pencil skills; writing skills, reading for fluency, key words (P2) Numeracy: Numbers 0-5, sorting (P1) Numbers 0-20, bigger/ smaller numbers, number names, (P2) WAU: Toys and CHRISTMAS :-

P2/3: Literacy: Reviewing letter sounds, phonics spelling and independent sentence writing. Numeracy: Addition/ subtraction, Time: o'clock and half past times

WAU- Autumn and Christmas

P3/4: Literacy: Nouns, verbs and adjectives. Santa letters and 'Flat Stanley' (novel study). Numeracy: 3D Shape, Addition and Subtraction and Problem solving.

WAU: 'I am unique' (focus on the body organs and their roles)



P5/6: Literacy: Adjectives, Proofreading and

Comprehension.

Class Novel: 'Danny the Champion of the World.'

Numeracy: Time (Durations), Column Addition, Column Subtraction (Decomposition) and Problem Solving.

ICT: Coding using Scratch. WAU: The Animal Kingdom.

P6/7: Literacy: letter writing, newspaper reports, speech marks, onomatopoeia, alliteration, proofreading, comprehension, 'Boy in the back of the class' (novel study) Numeracy: measure, coordinates, shape and angles WAU: Space.
