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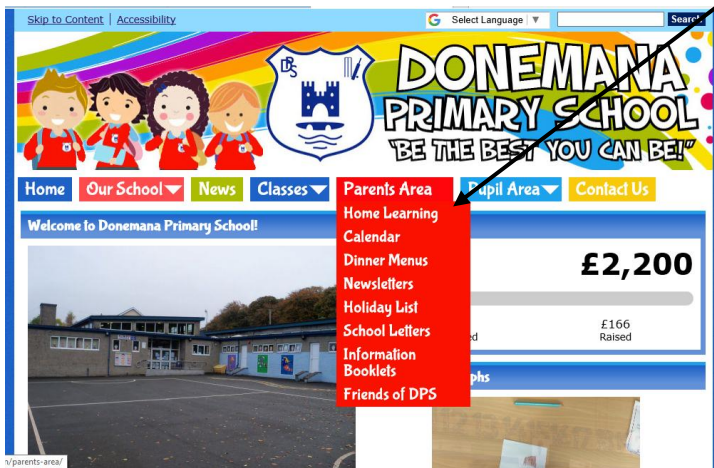

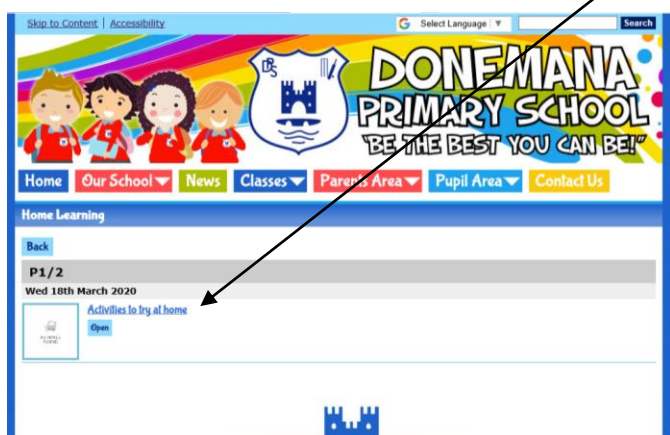

Click on your child's class and the activity your child's teacher wants them to complete will be there.



Children will be asked to complete approximately 3 literacy and 3 numeracy activities per week and there may also be some larger topic projects to complete over a longer period of time.

Children are also expected to continue with Spelling Shed <https://play.edshed.com/> and Accelerated Reader - <https://ukhosted42.renlearn.co.uk/2252872/default.aspx> (teachers will check their progress remotely each week).

We also recommend children use supermovers <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/supermovers> and C2k newsdesk. C2k newsdesk is being written with a focus on home learning during the period of closure and children can access it by logging in to 'My School' with their usual school username and password.
